

Grace Fort Gouldsby Scholarship Foundation Application

Statement of Purpose:

The Grace Fort Gouldsby Scholarship Foundation awards scholarships for the purpose of recognizing high school seniors in the state of Texas who have demonstrated outstanding and committed service in their community as well as academic excellence. This award is intended to provide financial assistance to such students in attaining their educational and career goals.

Scholarship Award:

The Grace Fort Gouldsby Foundation Scholarship will award one scholarship a year to a Texas high school senior planning on attending an accredited college or university. The Scholarship will award \$1,000 to the student and will be dispersed bi-annually.

Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible for the Grace Fort Gouldsby Scholarship Foundation award you must:

- Be accepted to attend an accredited College or University
- Be a graduating high school senior and must graduate prior to September 1 of the Award year
- Must be a Texas resident

- A signed recommendation from someone familiar with the applicant, except parents or other relatives
